Summary Statement:	Changes to Dampier and Karratha Bus Services		

## **Details**

Recently Rio Tinto commenced the new roster start and finish times in Dampier and as a result Karratha/Dampier bus service timetables remained misaligned. After careful consideration to all departments, amendments to the current timetable have been made to reflect current operations in Dampier.

The amendments to the Dampier timetables will be introduced in two phases, with the first phase commencing 12 May, 2017.

## Phase 1

- Karratha Town bus service start times are reduced to meet current operations.
- Central Area Transit (CAT) bus services will be introduced for Dampier intra port services. The reduced number of stops allows increased service frequency within the same service timeframe.
- The new CAT bus services are called CAT 1 and CAT 2.
- CAT 1 will stop at Warehouse and Planning departments.
- CAT 2 will stop at Port Ops and MEM departments.

## Phase 2

- Reduce the number of town stops in Karratha to meet current operations.
- Revisit the Dampier airport arrival and departure schedule to meet current operations.
- Phase 2 changes are scheduled to commence 10 June, 2017.

Please find attached the new timetables for Phase 1 and note these changes take effect from 12 May.
